ACHIEVEMENTS

1. Our team has diligently worked on creating the **theoretical materials** that will be essential for teachers, volunteers, and IDSPs. These materials have undergone rigorous testing to ensure their effectiveness.
2. Each partner in our project conducted an in-depth **analysis** within their respective countries. They engaged with 15 IDPs to identify gaps in their ICT knowledge. Simultaneously, surveys were administered to 15 teachers and volunteers who work with IDPs to determine the most suitable methodology for our upcoming manual.

The DigitalPUSH Manual is a crucial resource for educators and professionals supporting Intellectually Disabled People (IDPs). Combining **theoretical insights with practical guidance**, it equips teachers and volunteers with essential skills to navigate the digital landscape and empower IDPs.

Focused on promoting accessibility and enhancing digital proficiency, the manual addresses the increasing demand for **digital skills** in remote and technology-driven environments. By bridging the digital divide, it contributes to a more inclusive future of work and learning for individuals with intellectual disabilities.

This manual has **9 modules** in which a short introduction to the basic fundamentals of new technologies, the use of e-mail, digital reading tools, information search engines, text and slide editors, the use of spreadsheet, canva and some final recommendations on the good use and the dangers that they entail.
