SITUATION

The lack of global data on digital skills among people with disabilities is concerning, given the increasing demand for digital skills. To bridge this gap and secure access to emerging digital job opportunities, individuals with disabilities must acquire new skills and enhance their competences, considering their typically lower education and training levels.





OBJECTIVES

- Development of the theoretical and practical material to use by teachers, profesionals and volunteers who works with IDPs
- Development of digital labs (practical methodology for learning the digital tools developed in the manual)
- Local training activity

RESULTS

Digital PUSH manual: consist of development of the theoretial material to be used by the teachers or volunteers and IDSPs. This will include a testing phase of all the materials and the development of a manual at the end of the PR1

Digital Labs: In this result we will develop the practical part of the project. Once defined all the theory in the manual "The digital push". We will have to study and develop the way in which the intellectually disabled persons acquire the practical knowledge of the first phase.
